Aims and Objectives of the Club

Membership

- Membership will cease on non-payment of fees due and/or by formal expulsion by the Committee.
- Any player wishing to leave or transfer from the Club must do so in accordance with Club and relevant competition rules.

Club Fee Rules

Free sessions

- The initial two sessions (4 hours) will be free. The player will then be asked to join the club and begin paying the annual membership fee and for the training/match session's either by monthly subs or on a pay as you play basis.

Membership types/concessions

Full:

- Those who are over 18 and do not fall into another of the concessions categories: Student:

- Anyone who is a full-time student in the UK can receive a discounted membership Under 18s:

- The club does not currently have a Junior specific training session or team, those under the age of 18 who join the club will be training and playing alongside the adult members.
- All members under the age of 18 should have this form reviewed and signed by a parent/guardian as well as doing so themselves

'Pay as you go' (PAYG) members:

- Those who may attend a few training sessions throughout the year but are not paying the annual membership fee.
- They are required to complete the membership form.
- PAYG members will only be eligible for league match selection if there are less than 6 Full Members available, or unless they play a required position
- The Committee must be made aware of any player choosing to be a PAYG member Family Membership:
 - If a family has two full paying adults as members of the Club, subsequent immediate family members will be entitled to free membership.

<u>Kits</u>

- Kits are purchased by members, and new members will be required to purchase a full kit upon joining the club if they wish to play in competitive matches. New kits must be bought and numbered in consultation with the Committee so as to avoid overlap in numbers.

Session Types/Matches

- The Club offers multiple volleyball sessions a week, balanced between social play and team/individual improvement.
- During the months that the tournament takes place, some of these sessions will be taken up when the Club is hosting home games.

Special Tournaments

 Throughout the year the Club may be invited to attend different tournaments outside of those the teams have signed up to for the winter league. Participation in these events may be partially/fully self-funded rather than covered by the membership payments

Outdoor Sessions

- During the summer months the Club will host outdoor recreational sessions.
- These constitute Club sessions, and therefore PAYG members are liable to pay a contribution for attending.

<u>Beginners</u>

- The decision to play a beginner in a match will be made by the team coach/captain.
- Beginners will be expected to have attended training, gained a skill level commensurate with the match standard, and have gained the confidence to become part of the team.

Membership Payment Schedule

- Fees are paid either upfront at the start of the session or directly into the club bank account via Standing Order on the first day of each month.
- Your annual membership is to be renewed annually on the 1st September.
- Monthly fees are based on dividing the cost of the Sports Halls over 12 months and must continue to be paid over the summer months.

Missed Payments

- Members in default of two months' fees will be asked to give reasons to the committee. Members continually in default will have been deemed to have left the club.
- Players in default will not be eligible for match or tournament selection. If a member has an existing debt to the Club, they will not be able to return until the debt has been paid.
